Jake B said it is in the 12 Traditions to be fully self supporting. Tony said that an addict that goes to meeting can get literature but other people that can't need to be able to get it. Tonya M ask do we feel like it is a rotating issue and that we might need to go an H&

I meeting and tell them this is not ok and if it is a rotation issue we need to deal with it. Nick W said we are all adults here and ask what groups had the literature. Jason K said it was Section Serenity and Shot of Serenity Groups. Steve M said maybe trusted servants don't fully understand their responsibilities. Greg M said that it would be brought up at H&I. Tony G said stepping up got literature through ASC and H&I to help start their meetings. David W said he would find out where the literature came from that was at his group. Tonya M said that we were all clear H&I would take care of it.

Jerry A asked if secretary could only read old and new business on report. Everyone agreed.

Nothing was missing at audit. Nothing will no longer be paid in cash at ASC. Checks will be written to leave paper trail.

\$565.72 beginning balance, \$151.25 was deposited.

Hello Jim Nick and I'm an addict,

Thank You ~~for~~ allowing me to serve in my own capacity and ~~in~~ whatever way I see fit. I received a bank statement this past week and the ending beginning balance for this month was \$10 more than the figures we had. After searching we found that our rent check for \$10 had not yet cleared. So our figures were correct. We have \$565.72 cents available balance today.

During our audit, we came to the conclusion #1 that nothing was missing from the treasury, and #2 even if there was, we would not be able to track it on the account of the fact that we had been paying things with cash here at the ASC. So with that being said, we will no longer pay anything with cash on the ASC floor. All payments will now be made by check, thus leaving a paper trail and covering all asses.

Chris M called me today and said

that our rent was \$20 monthly and that the check should be made out to Rainbow City Professional Firefighters. \$157.25
I made the deposit the following Tuesday after our last AGL. And communicated with the bank ppl there in Scottsboro explaining our situation. They said they would send statements to my house, they removed Lori and said that when we needed to add anyone just to bring em in. I think we are good and I will do my best to stay on top of dis shit.

RCM REPORT: Kris L. Jason K read an email from Kris L that stated he would be resigning after RSC due to lack of resources and that he would be attending school. No hard copy. But he would be our voice at region this month.

PI REPORT: Mike E. (See attached)

Hello Family,

I'm Mike and I'm an addict, it's a great day to be clean and serving this area as well as NA as a whole. PI is still doing well and serving our purpose. During the last ASC there was some discussion about GSR's talking to their homegroups and try to encourage more participation on the phonenumber, hopefully we will hear some good news today. As for the phonenumber it was very active this past month taking in 43 calls with 104 minutes of talk time. The L.I.F.E. Group in Sylacauga had to cancel the Flyer Day that was scheduled for January 11th. I have done a little research on the cost of a billboard and of course the prices vary depending on size and location of the billboard but we are looking at somewhere in the range of between \$75 and \$200 a month rent on a billboard in rural areas. We need to discuss this and see if it's practical at this time. We are still waiting to reschedule a visit to the Family Life Center in Gadsden (more will be revealed). I've made 2 phone calls and sent an email to the Marshall County Court Referral about possible doing a Presentation but have not heard back from them, I will make another call this coming week. Thank you for allowing me to serve.


