#### **COUNTER PROPOSAL**

RCM and RCM Alternate shall be funded 50% of room rate for overnight lodging if travel exceeds 100 miles one way. RCM and RCM Alternate shall be funded 50% of room rate for 2 night lodging if travel exceeds 200 miles one way. The RCM and RCMA shall be given the sum (RCM and RCMA together) of 20 cents per mile travel expenses. Room receipt and/or mileage statement are required. No reimbursement for food expenses will be allowed for RSC attendance.

Room receipt and/or mileage statement are required. No reimbursement for food expenses will be allowed for RSC attendance.
