Hey family! Chris, addict.

Hope y'all are well enjoying another day clean. Our next RSC in Gadsden on April 21 & 22, 2018 at The Fairfield Inn & Suites/Marriott. Hope to find some willing addicts to assist me in setting up food, drinks, snacks and the conference room. Frankie H will be catering our Saturday lunch at the hotel. Normally in the past RSC the RCMs & administration committee attends a local meeting on Saturday night. There are not any meetings in Gadsden on Saturday night. Closest meeting is CTC. I would like to have a meeting at the hotel in their conference room so our local fellowship could have a meeting with them instead and just hangout if they want. The primary alternative is to have it at the church GOD meets in. Jason is to ask if this is feasible and if so the cost. I have been given \$600 by our Region to accommodate the RSC. I hope we can return as much as possible back to our region.

All RSC positions are open for nomination except for FITS, Surrender, RSC Secretary and RSC PI Chair. There weren't any nominations brought this past RSC. I also sent you a copy of the World Boards request to allow the RDs to change the FIPT at this year's WSC. I am pretty sure you got it and said no way. I will be taking our areas conscious on these Tally Sheets to RSC along with our areas BLOCK of Surrender in The Mountains request for increasing Seed funds.

Our Areas Proposal to discontinue transferring funds to the next lower level of service until SFLR FIPT request is resolved was sent back to the areas and Regional Policy for consideration. All funds are currently being held in our region until consensus and policy review. (Included in my RCM report and Regional minutes is SFLR attorney letter to NAWS.)

The regional proposal I need an area conscious to fund Central Alabama Area, \$1,000 for their area convention due to its loss of funds this past year.



It's a great day to be clean! We had an awesome month of March at Freedom Group! First of all, we want to thank Outreach for coming out to spend St Patrick's Day with us and facilitate our Group Inventory! I am pleased to report that we had *eleven* home group members present for this event. I am also grateful to say that the enthusiasm didn't end there. Thursday night, April 5<sup>th</sup>, we had *twelve* home group members present for our business meeting.

Our group feels that we are effectively carrying a clear NA message and that newcomers & visitors are being made welcome. Our attendance is steady, ranging from 11 to 55 people per meeting. We are in good relations with our meeting facility and the community. We feel that our meeting format is providing sufficient direction, but our group inventory directed us to make some changes, or to "*spice up*," our Thursday night meetings. We will now have rotating formats on Thursday nights; i.e., every other week we will rotate between Candlelight meeting and Around the Room Newcomer meeting. Also, in *May* we will be opening a noon meeting every Tuesday. We strongly feel there is a need to increase accessibility to meetings for addicts that work 2<sup>nd</sup> shift in our area. Before we open this new noon meeting, we must have another chairperson workshop which will be held on April 19<sup>th</sup> @ 5pm.

We feel that the group's funds *are* being used wisely. We had a beginning balance of \$0.42. We collected \$266 from 7<sup>th</sup> tradition donations & lit sales. We paid \$100 for rent, \$11 bank fees, & \$25 for supplies. For the second month in a row we have completely depleted our literature in stock except for one JFT; henceforth, we are spending the remaining \$130 on literature, leaving us unable to make an area donation this month. Our ending balance is \$0.42.

In March our treasurer resigned, but we are so grateful that Stephanie L is willing to serve as our new treasurer. Our previous Alt Lit Chair, Bryan D, accepted the position for Lit Chair.

In new business, an addict stated that the Marshall Community Corrections Work Release Program is extremely interested in having NEAANA bring in a meeting to their program. Executive Director Marcheta Shaw (cell phone #256-572-6102) is requesting a phone call to discuss the possibility of bringing a meeting to the men and women participating in this program.
