Hope y'all are well enjoying another day clean. I attended the last RSC in Dothan, AL. I have the receipt for our donation of \$24.27. I will need reimbursed for one night's lodging (I roomed with regional PI Chair so one night was covered by Region). I have the receipt for hotel (\$111.87) I traveled with Regional PI & Webmaster so gas was covered by region. Our next RSC in Birmingham on September 29 & 30, 2018 at **Holiday Inn 156 Resource Center Pkwy. Birmingham, AL 36303. Open RSC positions are Regional Secretary, Outreach Chair, & H&I Chair. Yvonne was nominated for Vice Chair of FITS. Her clean date is 11/3/9, she is from Pensacola, FL. Rhonda R. from Birmingham is nominated for Regional Treasurer (she has been treasurer before and is currently Alternate Regional Treasurer.) Ladonna M. is nominated for Surrender Chair (she is currently the Vice Chair.) Her clean date is 11/7/06 & she is a member of Conscious Contact Group in Tallahassee, Alabama. I will need area conscious on these nominees & any nominations you may have by next RSC.

An Ad Hoc Committee was formed to assess and formulate a plan to incorporate our RSC for tax & insurance purposes. We added to the incorporation all the areas so the groups could be covered too. This will add approximately 6-7 Thousand dollars to the cost of incorporating. This will have to be taken back to the groups too. I will also need our ASC annual operating budget to give to this ad hoc committee so they can put this in the articles of incorporation. There is also a proposal for all The regional proposal to fund Central Alabama Area, \$1,000 passed. The earmarked funds were increased to \$5,000 for struggling areas. This will need taken to our groups for conscious. The policy change to send proposals back to areas when it is sent to policy has been approved. I carried our areas BLOCK of Surrender in The Mountains request for increasing Seed funds. The block was ruled invalid. The Surrender Committee is currently below their budget. All Lodge rooms are full & there are rooms in hotel and campsites available. FITS kept its Prudent Reserve & turned over +7K to Region. The FITS treasurer was not at RSC for the FITS audit. It will be done before next RSC by Regional Treasurer, 2 RCMs, & FITS Treasurer. Southeast Zonal is requesting those interested in PR to join their weekly web meeting & wanting members stories on their transition from prison to outside recovery. The webmaster has renewed our regional host/domain. Books were purchased for Marrianna, Florida Prison H&I & the area RCM will take them there. There is a proposal to convert our Regional phoneline to YAP due to less cost and more efficiency. The other Regions in our Zone and around the US use it also. Proposal to buy a scanner for our Regional minutes past (approximately \$129.00) Proposal to send our Regional PI Chair to Camp Sumatonga for the AADAA conference on 10/3-10/5/18. PI Chair will provide expense report at next RSC. The funding for PI at bus stops was deemed too expensive at this time. Looking into free TV and radio PSA. Consensus was given for \$143.40 web hosting fee. The RSC funds are no longer being held due to the FIPT Inspection being done. I did not get the minutes from last RSC yet. Therefore, I do

not have the RSC Treasurer report. To the best of my knowledge after all funds were paid and held for earmarked funds there is about 1K to send to NAWS at this time. MWBR.

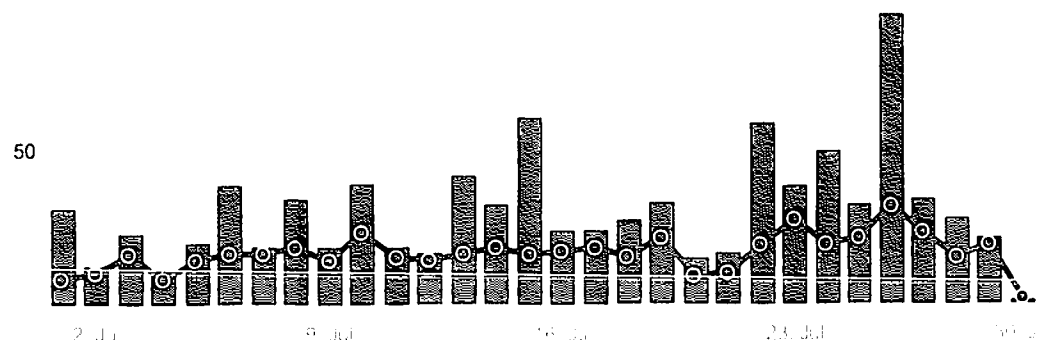

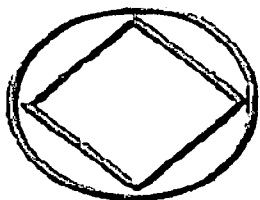
