

Hello, ASC family,

Freedom Group held our last business meeting on Thursday, September 1st. All trusted servants were present, except for our Treasurer. Alt GSR & Alt Lit positions remain vacant at this time.

This month was our first time to hold our business meeting on a Saturday, and it was a great success There were 20 addicts attending, and we were able to begin the meeting with a group study of the $1^{\rm st}$ Concept.

In open forum: Due to several requests, the group decided to hold a chairperson workshop on Saturday, October 6th right after our next business meeting. An addict suggested that we add another noon meeting to our schedule since the Wednesday meeting has been so successful. The group's conscience was to pray about this for a month and make a decision at the next business meeting.

We feel that the group is effective in carrying a clear, NA message, and we feel that newcomers & visitors are being made welcome. To improve on welcoming the newcomer, the group decided that whenever an addict picks up a white key tag, to be sure that we give them a copy of the group's phone list at that time. We feel that our attendance is steady and growing & that we are in good relations with both the facility and the community. This month we addressed the Thursday night meeting format. We will continue to rotate formats between "Candlelight Mtg" and "Newcomer Mtg," but we will no longer go around the room asking everyone to share on the nights we hold a Newcomer meeting; instead, it will remain open discussion and topics will come from Steps 1, 2, & 3.

We feel that the group's funds are being used wisely. Our beginning balance was \$18.07. 7^{th} tradition donations and lit sales totaled \$362 this month. Expenses were \$100 Rent, \$11 Bank Fees, \$180 Lit Purchase, & \$50 Supplies. Freedom Group is making a \$20 donation to ASC this month, leaving us with an ending balance of \$19.00. We also took a group conscience to adjust the group's book prices in response to World increasing the costs of books.

Our group continues to express a strong interest in an H&I and phone line volunteer workshop. We were hoping that there is another group in the area that is willing to host this workshop because it difficult for us to hold events at our meeting place. Last month, our group requested a Tradition's Learning Day; but the dates that I brought to area last month were not far enough in advance. Since the church has not given us new dates to work with, this request has been put on hold. On the otherhand, our group has resumed studying the Traditions at our Closed Discussion, Book Study Meetings on Monday nights. We would love to see you guys there!

At one time or another, most area committees have asked themselves whether a particular meeting should be included on that list. The six points describing an NA group appearing at the beginning of the "NA Group" chapter in this guide have given most area committees the criteria they've needed in making such decisions.

In the spirit of autonomy, many groups hold meetings that appeal to members with similar needs. The freedom from judgment expressed in the Third Tradition is aimed at helping any addict, anywhere, feel comfortable in NA. No matter how a group structures its meetings, all NA groups are encouraged to keep the focus of their meetings on recovery from the disease of addiction. As long as a group observes the Twelve Traditions and espouses the Twelve Steps of NA in its meetings, it may consider them Narcotics Anonymous meetings.

Since most groups are not directly connected with each other, we might think that whatever happens in our meetings has no effect on anyone else. When we consider who is affected by our group, we have to look at other groups, the addict yet to come, the newcomer, and the neighborhood in which we hold our meetings. We have an effect on other groups or NA as a whole if we're not recognizable as an NA meeting. It helps to remember what we needed to hear when we were new; hope for recovery from drug addiction. Addicts first coming to NA often look closely for differences, hoping that somehow they won't fit in. It's not difficult to alienate an addict. It's important to think about the message we send to newcomers in our meetings. Thoughtful consideration of our primary purpose may help ensure that meetings will be available for those addicts yet to come.

 When a group comes to the ASC requesting to join the ASC and be on the meeting schedule, the Area Chair should explain what determines if they are in fact an NA Group according the six points on page two of The Group Booklet. The Area Chair should read the 2nd paragraph on page 56 of The Guide To Local Services, the six points on page 2 of The Group Booklet, the last paragraph on page 153 out of the How & Why and the 2nd paragraph on page 154 out of the How & Why. The Area chair will then ask a series of questions, we don't expect the GSR to be able to answer the questions so we allow the GSR to take the questions back to the group so the members can answer and decide for themselves. If the GSR can answer the questions he/she will be allowed to answer at that time. In the event there's any question as to whether a group meets the six points then it will be the responsibility of the Area Chair/V Chair, two GSR's/GSR-A and two Admin members to visit that group to help make the determination. The Area Chair/V Chair will give a report at the next ASC. If it's determined a group doesn't meet the six points the ASC will refer the group to the Outreach Sub-Committee in an effort to help the group meet the six points if the group so desires.
