Chris, addict, hope everyone is having a great day in Recovery. I attended the RSC in Birmingham on 2/29 & 9/30/2018. I did not stay there. Choosing instead to drive back and forth those days. Gas totaled \$27.65 for the travel. I have receipts for these days & the receipt for our Regional donation of \$13.75. The next RSC will be in Mobile, Alabama on January 27 & 28, 2019 @ the Holiday Inn & Suites located @ 80 Springdale Blvd. Mobile, Alabama. The phone number is (251) 473-2380.
