Hello Family.

Per the area request, I did attend the RSC held in Daphne AL, on Nov 16th and 17th.

There was a review of how nominations and elections are supposed to be done. Positions open in January – Nominations submitted by groups and brought back in April with their qualifications. In July, the votes are counted, in October, the positions are filled for the following year. This was followed by a reminder that the FITS chair and VC positions are voted on in January, with the acknowledgement that the VC is automatic to go into the chair position.

There was discussion of the RSC meeting four times a year, every year, instead of the current cycle of 3 times on no CAR years and 4 times on CAR years. Proposal submitted to go back to area/groups.

Still vacant positions at the RSC are H&I, PI, Outreach, Vice chair, Alt secretary, Treasurer, and Alt Treasurer.

Webmaster gave us a workshop on how to update meetings, and how to navigate the ALNWFL website.

Surrender in the Mountains did really well this year, and had a \$5000.00 donation to give to the area.

Fun in the Sun has found out they can play bingo at the convention, but only prizes, not cash can be won. NO CASH PRIZES.

The region received Basic Texts from the East Coast Convention to be placed in jails and prisons. I asked for four of them to go to the jails in Marshall, Etowah, DeKalb, and Jackson county jail.

Roundtable was conducted on Saturday afternoon. On Sunday morning it was reminded to RSC participants that per area votes, the roundtable was

to be done on Saturday, and the business portion of the RSC start at 8 am on Sunday.

Here are the proposals that were submitted:

Webmaster – Two year contract starting in January 2020 and ending in December 2022. This was voted on and passed at the RSC.

That the RSC go back to meeting four times a year. The purpose is to better serve the areal, and consistency – Back to groups

That when a person is voted in as the Alternate or Vice of a committee, and that vote goes back to group, then the person is an automatic for the chair position and does not have to go back to groups- back to groups.

Here are the nominations submitted: Kenny G for Chair and Betsy U for Treasurer. Both of them are currently in the alternate position. Their qualifications are attached.

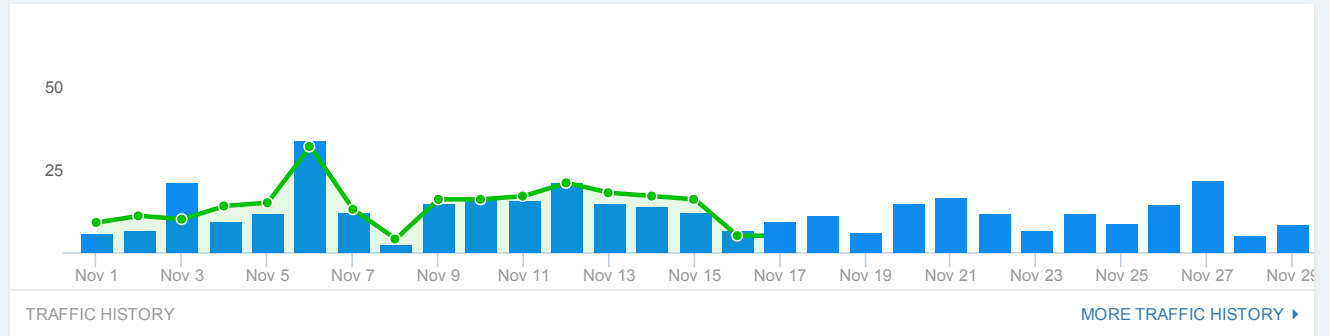
